Other Than This.....

So what is your story? Or, what is your story at this moment? If you think for a minute you'll understand what I am asking, you have many stories. About 90% of your conversation and interaction with others is telling or hearing a story. Often friendships are based on people having similar stories.

You probably know someone who 'launches' into their story as soon as you meet them. Their story will contain difficulties and how they were affected. They will go on to explain what they did or didn't do to handle each one and the outcome. The stories usually contain something personal—job, relationships, medical issues, etc. Having led a Creative Writing class for a few years, there were times I explained that all stories contain the same basic elements. While a story does have a beginning, a middle and end, the beginning is not just the first event in a series of three, but rather an 'emotionally engaging event'. The middle is the related consequence, and the end is the inevitable conclusion. **Simply put: You do not have a story until something goes 'wrong'.**

But what is 'wrong'? A story is about a person dealing with tensions and unfulfilled desire? There are also positive and beautiful stories which engage us as well. However, what's often shared has a greater portion of misfortune than fortune—"bad" news than 'good'. How either of these conditions are labeled, whether 'good' or 'bad', depend on whether they deny or fulfill the three basic desires--acknowledgement, security, and control.

As humans, we do enjoy those stories! Whether they are ours, or a friend's, a good novel, TV show or movie, most people are drawn to the entertainment of stories. One often gets considerable pleasure out of their own story, as it entails great obstacles and difficulties. Are you starting to see, from an objective point of view, your own story? Wonderful! Consider for just a moment what your life would be like without your story. Some story will still be there, always – but the difference is this: *you* are *NOT* the story. You are a Spiritual Being, an aspect of the Universe, a facet of the Diamond onto which is projected circumstances and situations, many not of your choosing.

Some choices you do make and yet have unintended outcomes. Divorce, health, or financial difficulties are unforeseen when choices are made. It happens. And those choices are guided by one of the desires mentioned earlier. There is nothing wrong with this. That's simply part of the human experience. Though many

times I have seen a person's understanding of a situation, or new information, or Truth accompanied by disbelief and rejection. A new perspective is kept from taking hold by the mind's need to: control the situation because it creates sensations of in-security and the mind can no longer acknowledge itself as a 'Know-It All'. The new information is therefore discarded. You may well be reading this article thinking "I don't have a story". That's ok, that's just part of your story.

Life without a story is wonderful. There is a freedom to it. Only what's right now is happening. There isn't any story to tell. No desire to impress anyone with what happened to you, with what you know, with how bad your 'what-ever' experience was. Accepting others as they are *right now*. Accepting *yourself as perfect* - right now, just as you are. Disengagement from your 'story' is liberating. Release yourself from a story based 'self' – to your true 'Self'.

Discussion Group

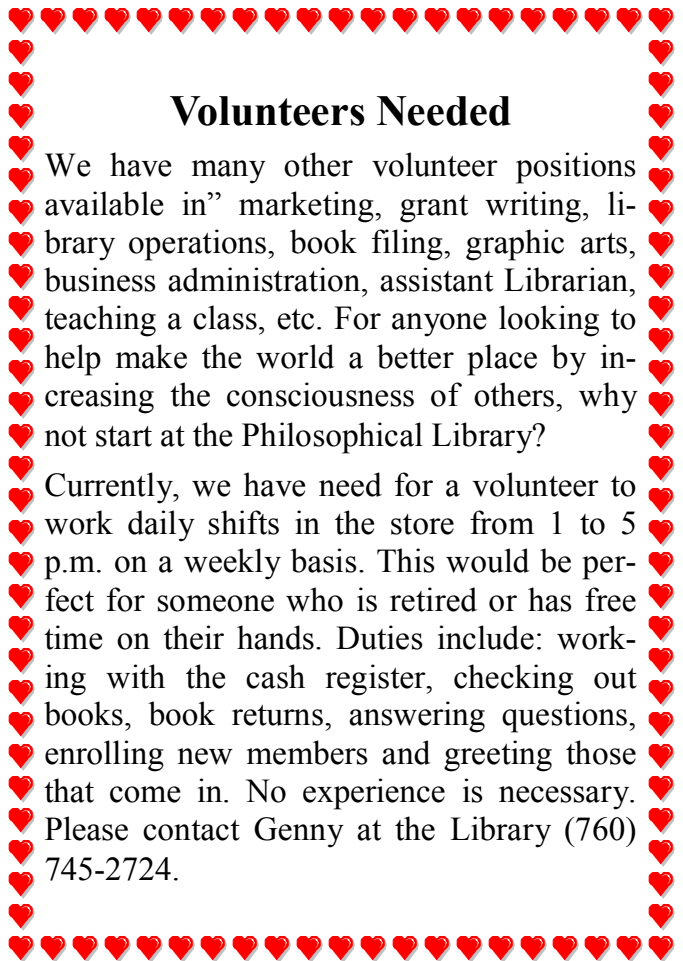
